All fellows are eligible to apply; however, only 25 fellows from institutions across the United States will be selected. There is no fee to participate. Each participating fellow will receive \$250 for tuition reimbursement.

SELECTION

Selection will be based on a review of clinical and research experience. Every effort will be made to select fellows with broad interests (e.g. practice setting goal: private, small partnership, group practice, academic setting). As space is limited, early applications will receive priority review.
