

**Don't Jeopardize My Eyesight
Call to Action: Contact Medicare**

Patients Using Eylea and Lucentis will be Impacted by Most Favored Nation Policy; Act Now to Ensure Access to Sight-Saving Drugs

Effective January 1, 2021, Medicare will begin to implement its Most Favored Nation (MFN) policy, which may limit patient access to sight-saving drugs. The MFN policy will reduce payment for Medicare physician-administered Part B drugs (including Eylea and Lucentis) to align with the lowest price found in comparable countries. As a result, your physician will have to pay more for these drugs than Medicare will reimburse. This flawed policy creates a difficult situation in which your doctor will be forced to choose between financial stability and optimal patient care.

Help save your vision by telling Medicare to stop the Most Favored Nation policy!

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Contact Medicare and tell them to stop the Most Favored Nation policy set to begin on January 1, 2021.

1. Call 1-800-MEDICARE (1-800-633-4227)

2. Tell the operator:

- Please stop the Most Favored Nation policy because it threatens my eyesight by limiting access to the medicine I need to maintain my vision.

3. Select a talking point:

- I have paid into Medicare for many years. [Eylea or Lucentis] is saving my vision. Why are you taking it away from me?
- I need [Eylea or Lucentis] to keep my sight. I may lose my vision if I have to change drugs or delay my treatments. Is that what Medicare is asking patients to do?
- Why is Medicare trying to take away medicine that helps me see?

4. Ask the operator to submit your complaint to the Medicare Beneficiary Ombudsman (MBO)
