

Keith A. Warren, MD

Upon graduation from the University of Virginia School of Medicine, Keith A. Warren, MD, completed his ophthalmology residency at the Medical College of Virginia, where he also served as Chief Resident in his final year. He then completed a 2-year fellowship in Diseases and Surgery of the Retina and Vitreous at the University of Illinois Eye and Ear Infirmary. Dr. Warren began his career as full-time faculty and was appointed the Residency Program Director at the University of Kansas. He was promoted to Professor and Chairman of the KU Department of Ophthalmology in 2000 and served KU in that capacity until 2005.

In 2005, Dr. Warren left full-time academics and founded Warren Retina Associates in Overland Park, KS. He remains a Clinical Professor at the University of Kansas and in 2019 he was selected to join the Board of Directors of the American Board of Ophthalmology. In addition, he is a member of the Board of Directors of the UVA Medical Alumni Association and is an active member of the American Academy of Ophthalmology, The Retina Society, The American Society of Retinal Specialists (Inaugural Chair of the ASRS DEI Committee), The European VitreoRetinal Society and the Sports Ophthalmology Society of the Americas. He has worked on multiple committees for the American Academy of Ophthalmology and The Retina Society and has served as both a member and Chair of the Retina Clinical Committee of the American Society of Cataract and Refractive Surgery.
