Paul Hahn, MD, PhD, FASRS

Paul Hahn, MD, PhD, FASRS is a retina specialist at NJRetina in northern New Jersey. He grew up in New York City and graduated magna cum laude from Harvard University with a degree in Biochemical Sciences. Following in the footsteps of his father and grandfather, both ophthalmologists, he completed his medical education at the University of Pennsylvania School of Medicine. He was sponsored by the National Institute of Health for completion of his MD along with a PhD degree in molecular pharmacology investigating novel treatment pathways for dry age-related macular degeneration. Dr. Hahn completed his ophthalmology residency at the Scheie Eye Institute at the University of Pennsylvania, followed by a two-year fellowship in vitreoretinal diseases and surgery at Duke University. After completion of his fellowship, Dr. Hahn remained at Duke University as an Assistant Professor of Ophthalmology and retina specialist for almost 4 years before subsequently joining NJRetina in 2016.

He is currently the Chair of the American Society of Retina Specialists (ASRS) Health Economics Committee and the Editor of the ASRS Preferences and Trends Survey. He serves on the editorial board of multiple ophthalmic journals and magazines. He has been the recipient of numerous prestigious honors and awards for excellence in ophthalmology research, receiving the Association of University Professors of Ophthalmology Resident Award, Ronald G. Michels Foundation Fellowship, the Heed Foundation Fellowship, and Honor Awards from both the American Academy of Ophthalmology and the ASRS.
