Dr. Sanders graduated with honors from the University of Virginia with a degree in Biochemistry and earned his medical degree from Yale University. After an internship at Yale-New Haven Hospital and residency training at Wills Eye Hospital, he completed a retina fellowship at Massachusetts Eye and Ear Infirmary/Harvard Medical School.

After fellowship, Dr. Sanders joined the Retina Group of Washington (RGW), where he has practiced to this day. He is board certified by the American Board of Ophthalmology and licensed throughout the DMV region. His hospital and academic affiliations include Georgetown University Hospital, Washington Hospital Center, Children's Hospital, and Howard University School of Medicine, where he holds clinical professorships. He has served as Chief of the Retina Service at Georgetown University/Washington Hospital Center from 2001 to 2022. Dr. Sanders is a recent past president of the American Society of Retina Specialists and currently is on the ASRS Board.
