Dr. Weng also serves as the Vitreoretinal Diseases & Surgery Fellowship Program Director. Dr. Weng graduated from Northwestern University, completed medical school at the University of Michigan, and earned an MBA degree from the University of Michigan-Ross School of Business (high distinction). She completed her ophthalmology residency at the Johns Hopkins University Wilmer Eye Institute and surgical retina fellowship at the Bascom Palmer Eye Institute-University of Miami.

Dr. Weng is a member of the ASRS Executive Committee and Board of Directors. She also holds multiple other leadership roles in organizations including Women in Ophthalmology, Macula Society, Retina Society, and American Academy of Ophthalmology. She is involved with many clinical trials and currently serves as the national Protocol Chair of DRCR Retina Network Protocol AO evaluating Home OCT in the management of wet macular degeneration.
